In the academic year 2021-2022, the Covid monitoring cell has been able to carry out excellent activities. Students were allowed to enter the college only on the days of university examination. In those days, teachers were assigned to monitor the children.

After thermal scanning, the children entering the college were properly monitored to wash their hands. Similarly, after the examination, the teachers were instructed to send the students out of the college without standing in groups and also appointed teachers for that purpose.
