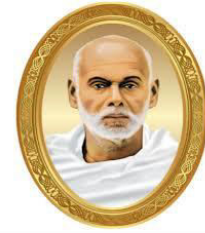

## **Paper Presentation Competition Rules and Guidelines**

- There is no limit to the number of student participants
- Entries for the contest shall be limited to one presentation per student and one student per presentation (Dual authorship is not permitted).
- Authors must be Under Graduate or Post Graduate students.
- Presentation theme must be Economics related.
- Participant must produce College ID for proving eligibility
- Theme of presentation should not have appeared in any publications.
- Students presenting the topic should not reveal their identity (own name/ college name) on their Power Point.
- Videos, charts, calculations, etc. can be included in the presentation.
- A student unable to present is automatically disqualified from the contest.
- Time for the presentation is limited to 10 minutes
- Contestants must arrive by 9:30 AM
- Judges will interact with the contestant at the end of each presentation and may ask any related questions and provide constructive comments. The time limit for questions and answers is 5 minutes.
- The presentations are “open” to audience including faculty members and students
- The prizes to the winners and participation certificates would be distributed in the valedictory session.
