9. Detailed description of the event:

Career Guidance Cell of SNM College Maliankara organized a Workshop on 25th September 2019 for Developing students English Communication Skill and their aptitude for ideal Group Discussion. Resource person Shri Shine spoke on the need of a comprehensive approach to be followed for developing English communication skills. In order to improve the language Proficiency, he suggested students for reading English newspapers, articles, and literature and thus to enhance language skills. Similarly students should practice listening to English podcasts, news broadcasts and watch movies or TV shows in English to improve comprehension and accent recognition. Speaking Skills among students can be improved by Encouraging their participation in debates, speeches, and presentations. Institution should provide opportunities for students to engage in regular conversations in English. Similarly students have to do tasks such as essays, reports and creative writing exercises to enhance their writing proficiency.

The resourse person Shri. Unnikrishnan D.S focussed his session on Group Discussion Techniques. He emphasised at the strategies for initiating, leading, active listening, structuring arguments and summarizing discussions. He pointed out the critical thinking and analytical Skills of students. Institution has to provide exercises that encourage students to analyse topics critically, supporting their viewpoints with evidence. Last but not the least he reminded students about managing their time effectively during discussions to ensure equitable participation. Above all students should have the skill for handling disagreements and conflicts respectfully and constructively.
