A faculty member acts as the secretary, a parent is elected as the vice president, a faculty member act as treasurer and Vice secretary is also a parent .These leaders play crucial roles in guiding the PTA's initiatives throughout the academic year. The Committee meets every month and discusses programs and activities of the College. PTA Executive Committee acts as a link between parents and institutions.

The PTA assists the overall development of the students by extending financial and other supports to the curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities of students. In the academic year 2021-2022, the SNM College Maliankara Parents-Teacher Association (PTA) continued its dedication to enhance the educational experience and welfare of our college community. This report provides an overview of our key initiatives and contributions during this period.

Infrastructure Improvements

- Auditorium Renovation: The PTA funded the renovation of the college auditorium ceiling, creating a more welcoming space for various events and gatherings.
- Women's Restroom Upgrade: To enhance convenience and comfort, we added a new toilet, washing facility, and wall fan to the women's restroom.
- Exam Room Enhancement: A photostat machine was provided in the exam room, simplifying the process of printing question papers.

• Ladies Hostel Water Purifier: Ensuring safe drinking water, a water purifier was installed in the ladies' hostel.

Support for Academic Excellence

- Guest Lecturers' Salaries: The PTA stepped in to provide salaries for guest lecturers who did not receive them from the Director of Collegiate Education.
- Day of Excellence: We organized a special event, the "Day of Excellence," to honour university rank holders, Chief Minister Excellence Award winners, and sports champions at the national state and university levels. Cash prizes were awarded to the top students in each department and winners of university cultural activities.

Supporting Our Student

- Financial Aid for Examination Fees: Due to the pandemic condition, many students are finding difficulty to pay the University fees in time. PTA extended their support by assisting them in covering their examination fees
- Physical Education Assistance: Breakfast and sports attire were provided to students in the Physical Education department, ensuring they had the resources to excel in sports and physical activities.
- COVID-19 Testing Support: During the pandemic, we assisted in COVID-19 testing to maintain a safe college environment.
- Financial Assistance: The PTA financially supported numerous college activities, including departmental events and cells like NSS, NCC, clubs like Bhoomitrasena, Readers Forum, Gender Equality Forum, Guidance and Counselling, and the Village Adoption Program.
- Internal Examinations: We facilitated the smooth conduct of internal examinations.
- Sanitizer Distribution: In response to the pandemic, we distributed sanitizers within the college to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Academic Advancements

- National Seminar and Journal Publication: The PTA provided financial assistance for organizing national seminars and publishing international journals.
- College Magazine: We extended support for the publication of the college magazine.

Supporting Our Community

- Souhridasandwanam Initiative: An effort by the PTA to assist students and their parents facing financial crises due to illness.
- Helping a Botany Student: We provided Rs. 10,000 in financial aid to a student from the Botany department who needed assistance.
