- 6) Attendance shortage for students have to take proper action


Feedback of Students

- 6. Activities/programs


The feedbacks from 1423 (Ist Feedback collection) were consolidated and analyzed in the current year to strengthen the quality of teaching-learning environment.































Valid Suggestions/Comments

Feedback of Parent


