- Tentative schedule for implementing actions in a proper manner





Feedback Report 2022-23

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of SNM College Maliankara has developed the feedback mechanism commencing with obtaining feedback from the various stakeholders - students, teachers, employers, parents and alumni through a structured based feedback form. In this year, we have formulated another set of questionnaire for teaching community who has greater contribution for syllabus and curriculum. This will help us to take action to make necessary revision required for each program and forward to the Register of affiliated University and the members of Board of studies of the concerned program. The IQAC draws feedbacks every year for continuous improvement in academic programs, curriculum development and enrichment. Based on the opinions of stakeholders, further actions are taken by IQAC to improve the college services and enhance the credibility of the institute. Through a feedback committee, the IQAC gathers and analyses comments from all stakeholders. From the 2022–23 academic year, the college features an online feedback system. All these feedbacks are well documented and recorded in the institute and the same report will be posted to the college website


Feedback of Students







Feedback of Alumni




Alumni Feedback, the following aspects were addressed

Feedback of Employer






Feedback of Parent


