**8. Objective of the Program:** To provide medical assistance to the community, especially those with limited access to medical facilities. The camp aimed to offer consultations, diagnosis, and treatment to patients.

9. Detailed Description of the Event: The medical camp was a collaborative effort between the NSS unit of SNM College and the Rotary Club of Kodungaloor, with support from Craft Hospital, Kodungaloor. The camp commenced with an inaugural function on the first day. HMDP Sabha Secretary Sri. T. S Bijil Kumar inaugurated the event. Distinguished guests included Rotary President Sri. Manoj Menon, Secretary Sri. C. X. Sebastian, HMDP Sabha President Sri. B. Rajeev, SNM College Principal Dr. Jitha T. H, Manager Sri. M. R. Bose, and Program Officers Dr. Resmi V. C and Sri. Vipin K. D. and NSS Secretaries of the college. Following the inauguration, an awareness class was conducted by Maju Jacob, the Chief Operating Officer of Craft Hospital. After the awareness class, medical professionals, including doctors and nurses from Craft Hospital, began consultations with patients. The first day of the camp catered to the teaching and non-teaching staff, as well as to the students of SNM College. Day 1 activities concluded at 3:00 pm.

On the second day, the medical camp extended its services to the villagers of Maliankara. Consultations commenced at 10:00 am and were conducted by medical professionals from Craft Hospital. Medicines were provided free of cost to patients on the second day. The camp successfully concluded at 3:00 pm.

10. Outcome of the Event/Evaluation by Program Coordinator:

The benefits of Medical Camp at SNM College Maliankara reached a diverse group of participants, including college staff, students, and villagers from Maliankara, effectively extending healthcare services to those in need. The awareness class conducted by Maju Jacob played a crucial role in educating attendees about various health-related topics, contributing to their overall health awareness. The camp provided an opportunity for individuals to consult with healthcare professionals, receive diagnoses, and access treatment, thus addressing their immediate healthcare needs. On the second day, the provision of free medications further eased the financial burden on patients and ensured they had access to necessary treatments.
