**8. Objective of the Program :** The main objective of the program was to assist in waste collection and disposal after the devastating floods in Kerala during August 2018. The program aimed to contribute to the cleanup efforts, raise awareness about environmental cleanliness, and provide assistance to those affected by the calamity. Through their involvement, the volunteers gained valuable insights into the challenges people faced during the floods and learned the significance of unity in collective efforts.

**9. Detailed description of the event:**The floods in Kerala during August 2018 were a tragic and unforgettable event. After the calamity, one major challenge was dealing with the waste left behind. Despite the tough job, nearly a hundred volunteers, under the guidance of the Programme officers, collected clothes, beds, and sofa sets submerged in water and mud from the affected houses. The collected waste was brought to a central location for processing.

The students enthusiastically engaged in volunteer activities, even disregarding the possibility of contagious diseases and other challenges. The Programme officers instructed the students to wear gloves and take preventive measures.

**10. Outcome of the event/Evaluation by Program Coordinator**As a result of their dedicated efforts, the volunteer students' spirit of service within the community was elevated, and they became better equipped to handle difficult situations. Through their involvement, the volunteers gained a firsthand understanding of the various difficulties people faced during the severe flood. They realized the importance of working together as a collective and maintaining environmental cleanliness.

The impact of their work was significant, as wastes were collected from approximately 400 houses in just two days. This outstanding achievement showcased the effectiveness and commitment of the NSS unit in assisting the community during times of crisis.
