Blended Teaching Learning Process

The covid pandemic situation demanded a transformation from the conventional modes of learning to the new system of teaching learning process through virtual medium. SNM College under the guidance IQAC switched over to the new normal through its Moodle platform SNMC Virtual, which incorporates varied online strategies for learning, evaluation and sharing E contents.

The MOOC Cell constituted under the guidance of IQAC promotes online learning courses offered through NPTEL SWAYAM. SWAYAM is a programme initiated by Government of India and designed to achieve the three cardinal principles of Education Policy viz., access, equity and quality. The objective of this effort is to take the best teaching learning resources to all, including the most disadvantaged. SWAYAM seeks to bridge the digital divide for students who have hitherto remained untouched by the digital revolution and have not been able to join the mainstream of the knowledge economy. The institution was registered as the local chapter of NPTEL SWAYAM where the students could enroll in different online certificate courses offered on SWAYAM platforms. The MOOC Cell also undertakes the MOOC Course on organic farming conducted by Mahatma Gandhi University.

The Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) established under the guidance of IQAC, fosters the innovative ideas generated among students and helps them acquire new platforms of career opportunities in entrepreneurship. IQAC organized a session on IPR to provide awareness on the legal framework of intellectual property rights. IQAC organized a two day multidisciplinary International Conference entitled Green Economy Initiatives: Perspectives and Challenges (hybrid mode) to facilitate green initiatives to students and to update them on new areas of research and innovation. The conference was led by eminent resource persons from across the globe and more than fifty scholars presented research articles. The proceedings of the conference were published in the Journal of Current Studies, the official journal published by the institution.
