These activities not only engendered a relatable context for the content but also instilled a pragmatic application of the acquired knowledge.

In the denouement of each session, valedictory ceremonies were conducted, affording participants an opportunity to proffer feedback pertaining to their experiential learning. Participants articulated how the program had catalyzed the enhancement of their communication skills and bolstered their self-assurance in deploying the English language with dexterity.
