- 8. Objective of the Program :** To create and update the Data Register about out of state workers in the district

9. Detailed description of the event:

NSS Volunteers of SNM College Maliankara engaged in an activity of collecting demographic / geographic details of the out of state employees in Munambam- Moothakunnam region. The data collection program was undertaken by the NSS volunteers at the direction and supervision of civil police officers of Vadakkekara police station and the Block Panchayath Office. Six volunteers joined with the police officers and communicated with the employees assembled at the Ice Plant (Shoolapani) premises at Maliankara. Original details of the out of state employees such as Aadhar Card number, blood group, identification marks on the physical body, phone number, Post Office, Railway Station, Police Station, Land marks were collected. Collected details were uploaded in the online data sheet provided by the authority. Details were also recorded against a unique identification number for each employee in a register maintained by the authority. Ultimately one ID card was generated and provided to the employees by displaying this unique identification number and few relevant information related to them. This ID card has to be safely maintained by the employees and to be produced on demand by any authority in the state.

10. Outcome of the event/Evaluation by Program Coordinator:

Students got an opportunity to work with the regional employment authority in collecting the details of the workers from other states in the nation. Students could interact with such workers from other states and use their computer skills to compile the details needed by the local authority.
