
c. Introduction and Welcome: The event begins with a brief introduction by the organizers, welcoming students and outlining the agenda for the book talk.






### 10. Outcome of the event/Evaluation by Program Coordinator:


- **a.** Increased Engagement with Literature: Participants develop a deeper interest in reading and exploring diverse literary works beyond their academic curriculum.
