- Tentative schedule for implementing actions in a proper manner.

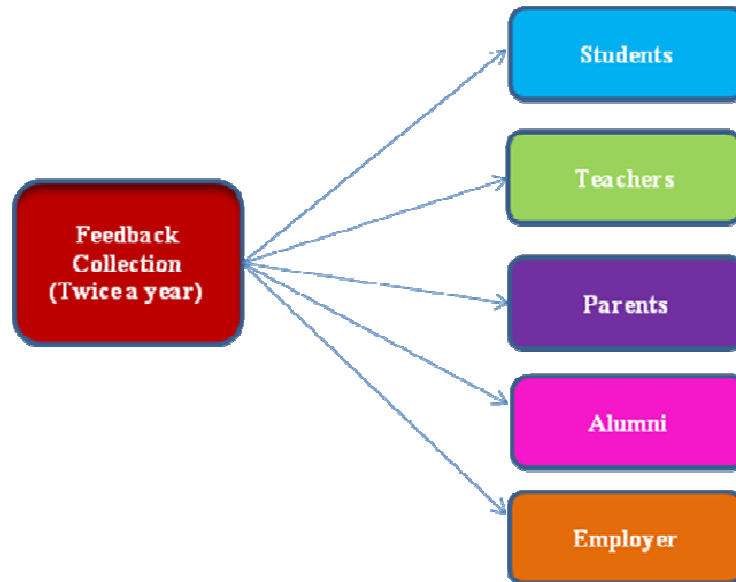
3. Check

Feedback of Teachers

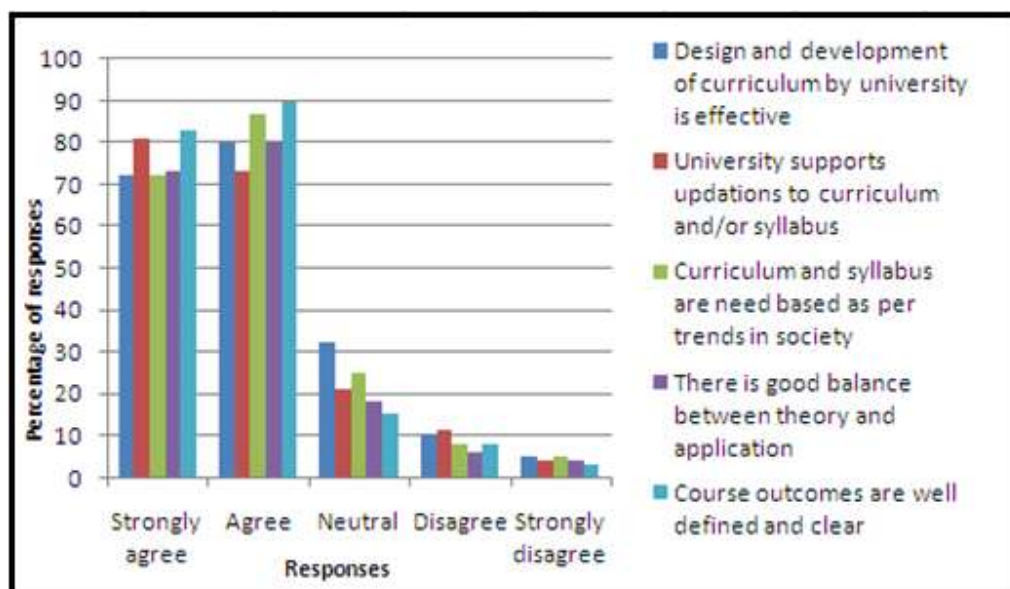

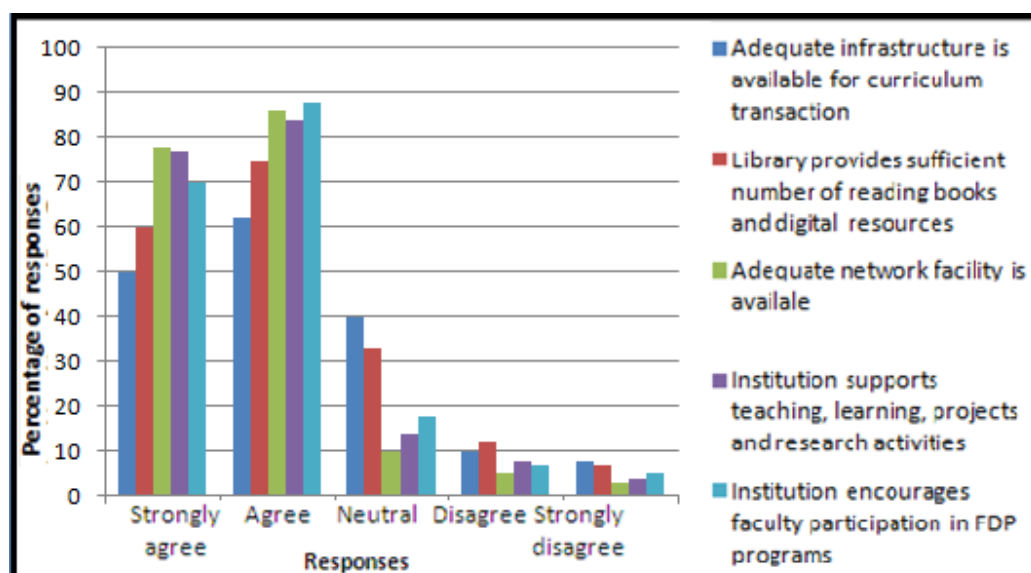

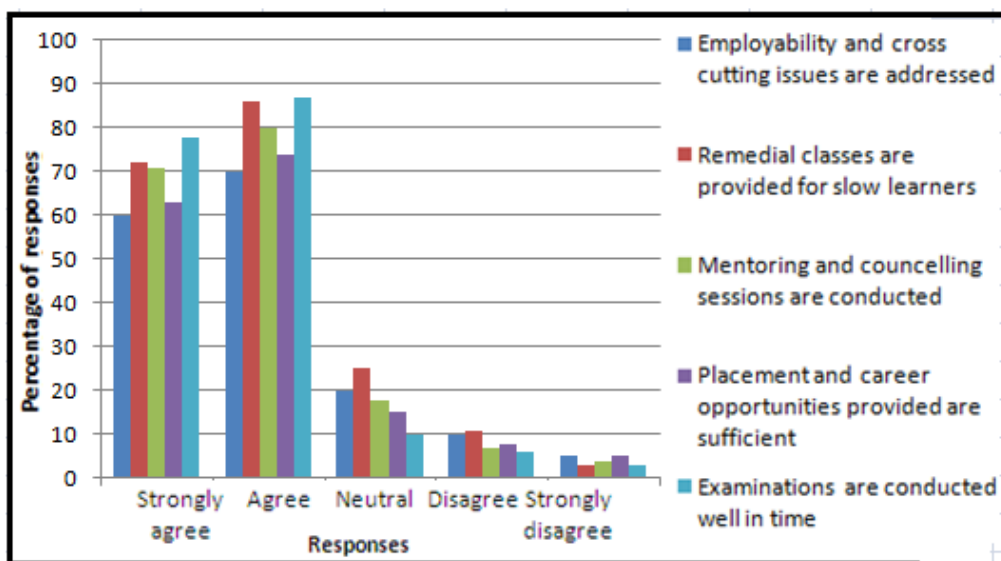
Syllabus and Curriculum

Feedback of Students

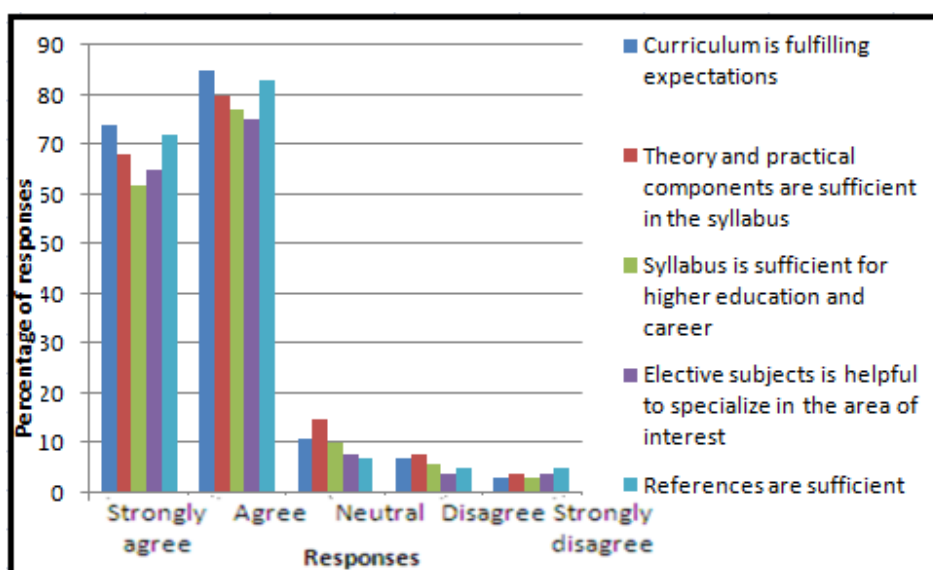

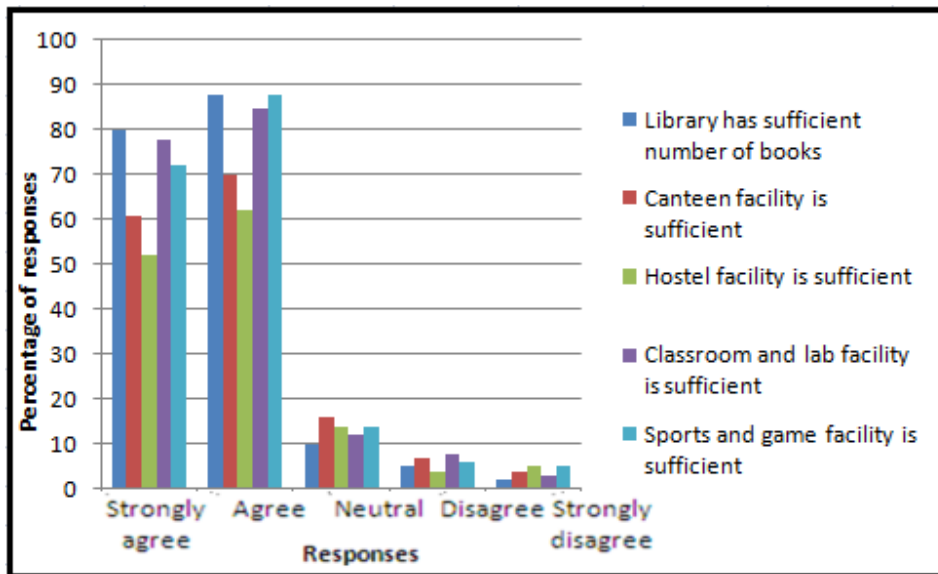

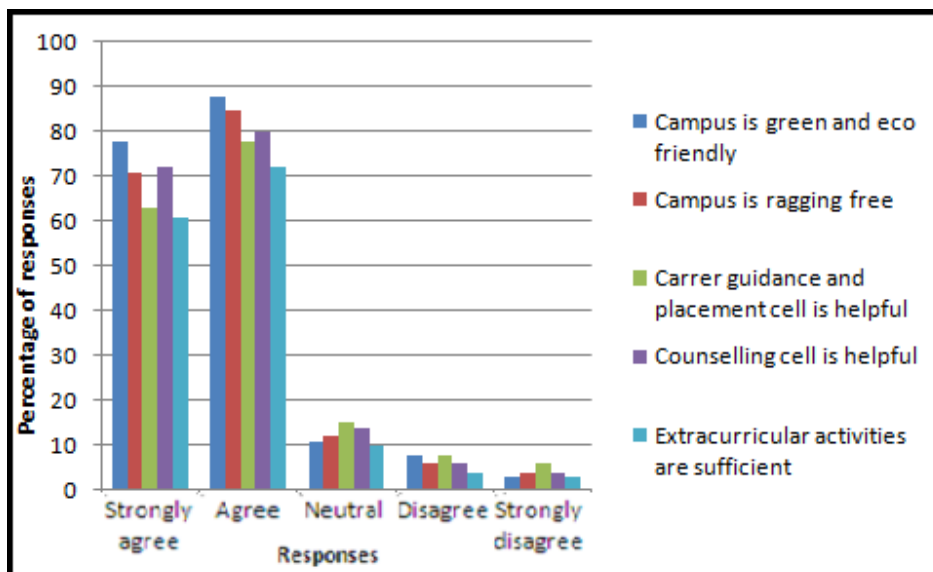

Feedback of Parents

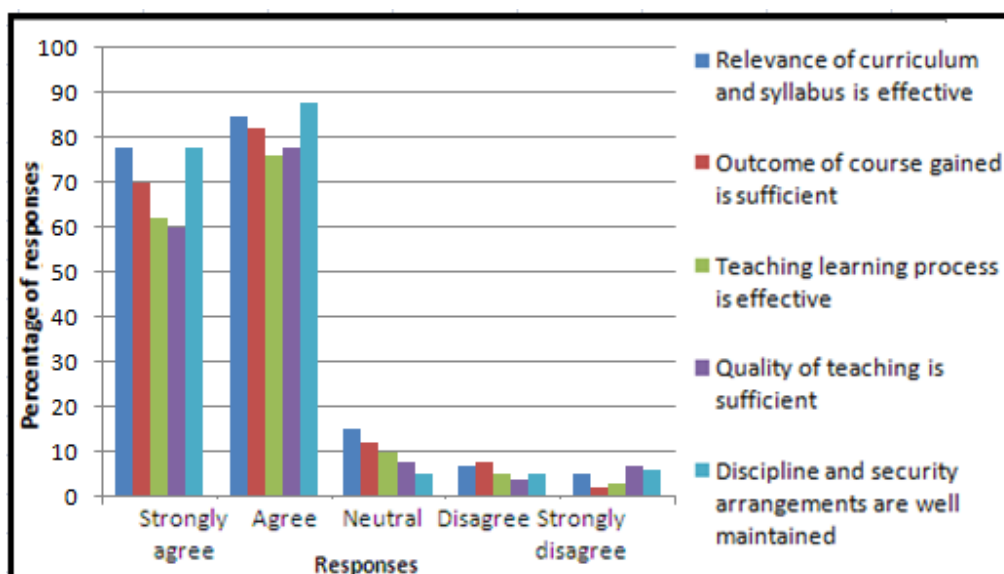

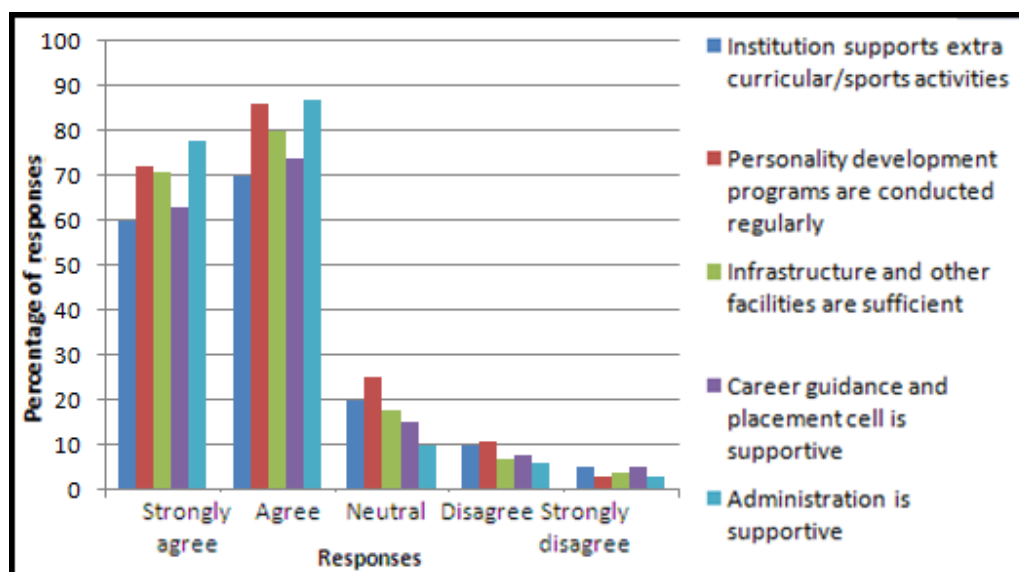

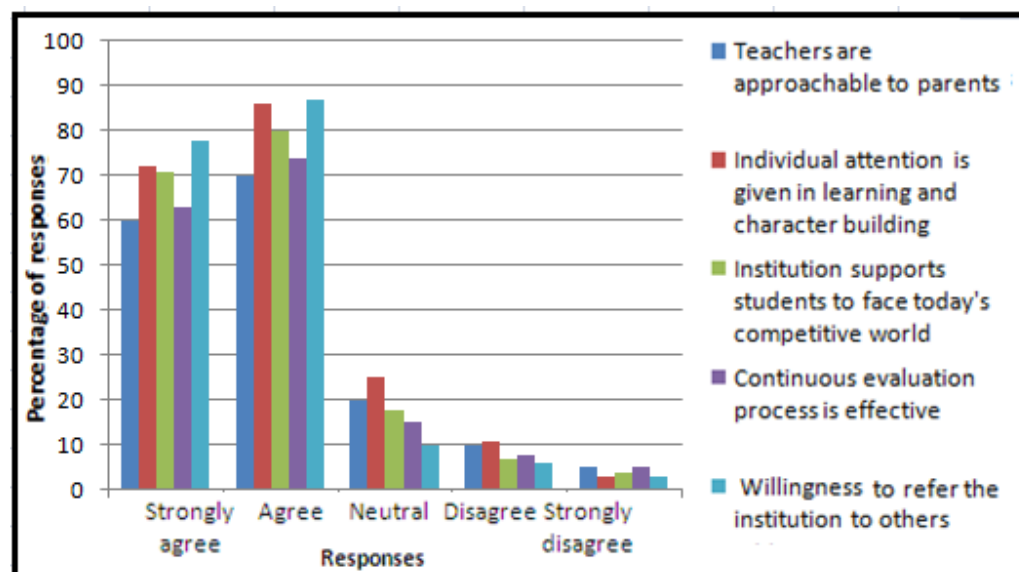
Syllabus, Curriculum and Teaching-Learning Environment

Feedback of Alumni

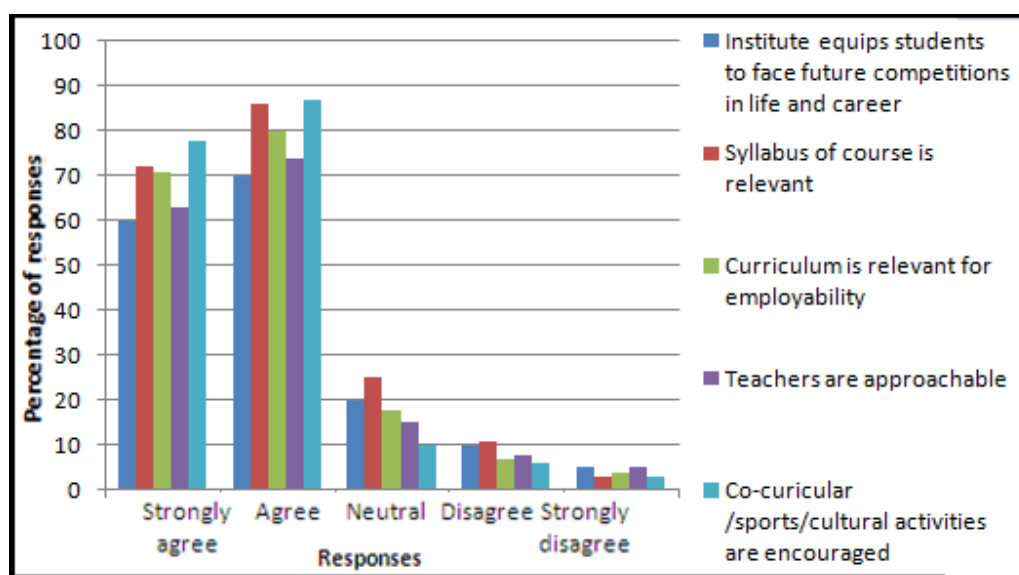

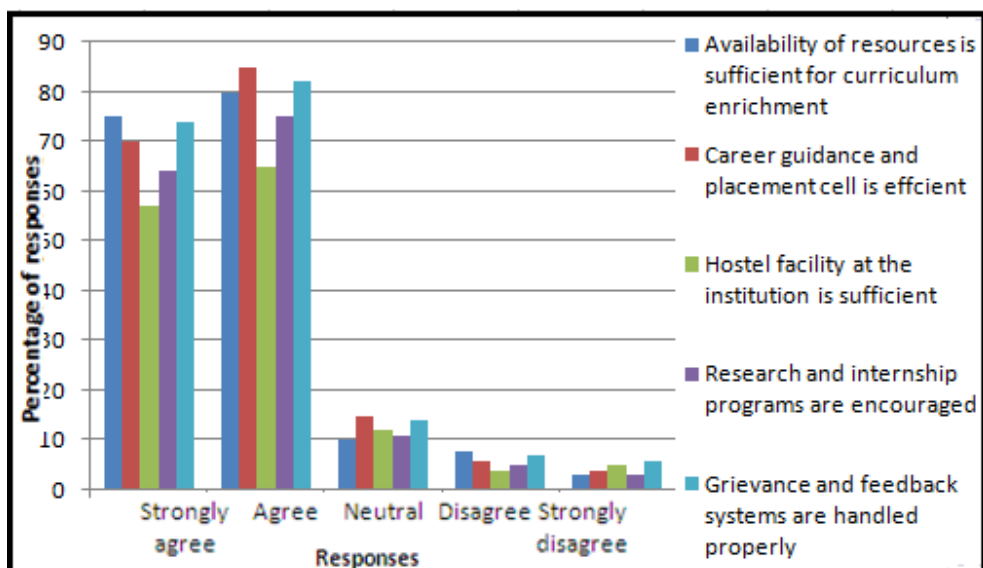

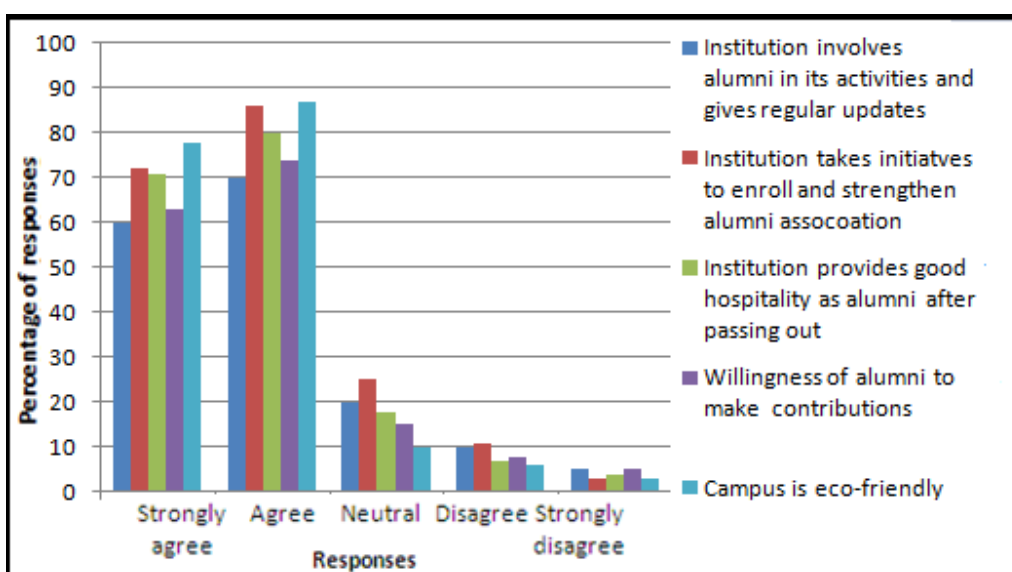
Syllabus, Curriculum and Teaching-Learning Environment

Feedback of Employer

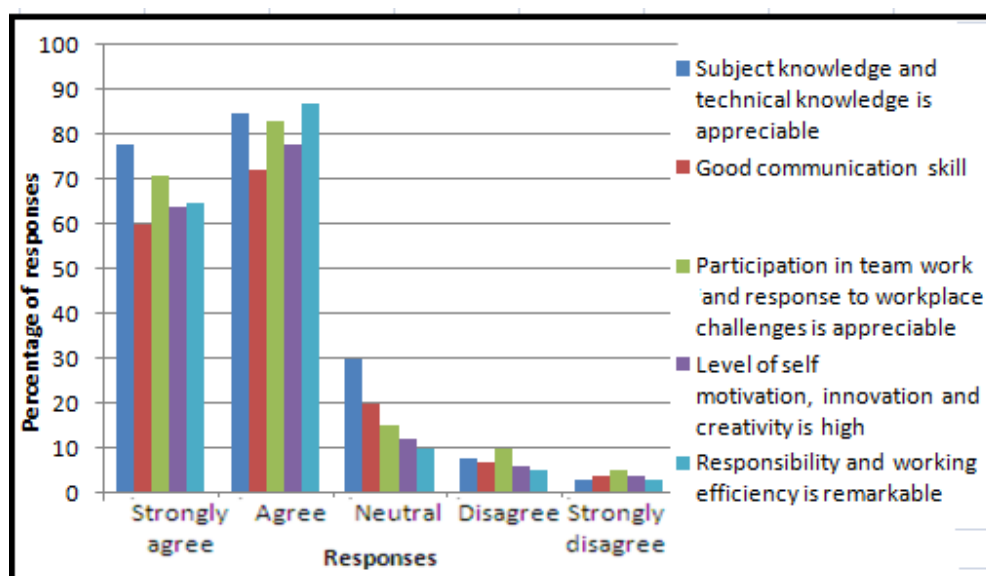

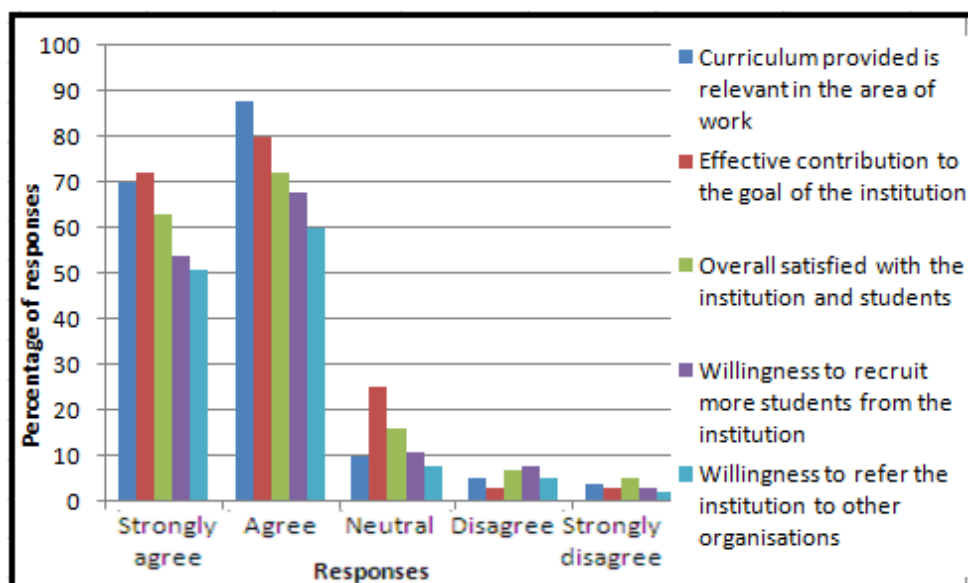
